Drum positioning and Door unlocking

Position the inner drum in front of the outer door with the

"Door unlocking button"

Loading

- Before launching a wash cycle, check the clothes - Empty the pockets, close zip and fasteners.
- Do not overload the drum and comply with the machine capabilities.

Adding detergents

- Machines equipped with a soap box can contain 2 powders and 2 liquids products, used during the pre-wash, main wash or rinse step according to the program.

Launching a wash program

- Use the control knob to select wash program, options and any other available functions.
- Turn the knob until the required option is shown on the • display.
- Confirm your choice by pushing in the knob.
- Repeat this procedure until all the required options have been chosen.
