Constructed in AISI 304 stainless steel. Table top model can be hanged on the wall with wall brackets (optional). Open on 3 sides. Incoloy heating element placed in the upper deck, and can be tilted for easy cleaning. Upper deck is movable, sliding up and down along runners. Single cooking area managed by an energy regulator. Air vents along the upper side for evacuating heat and smoke. Extractable drip tray and chromium-plated steel grid for easy cleaning.

Main Features

- Open 3 sides for rapid cooling and ease of use.
- Heat control with energy regulator.
- Single tilting incoloy armoured heating element.
- Cooking plate size: 400 x 350 mm accept GN 2/3.
- Heating element can be tilted for easy cleaning under the moving deck.

Construction

- Made of AISI 304 stainless steel.
- Air vents along the upper side for evacuating heat and smoke.
- Removable stainless steel drip tray.
- Movable upper plate.
- Chromium-plated steel grid with a safety stop to avoid accidental fall.
- Table top unit can be wall mounted with dedicated optional accessory.
- 4 rubber feet.

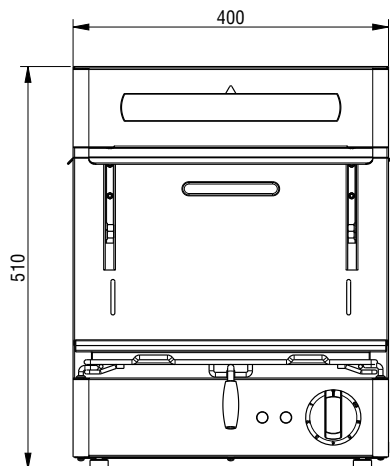
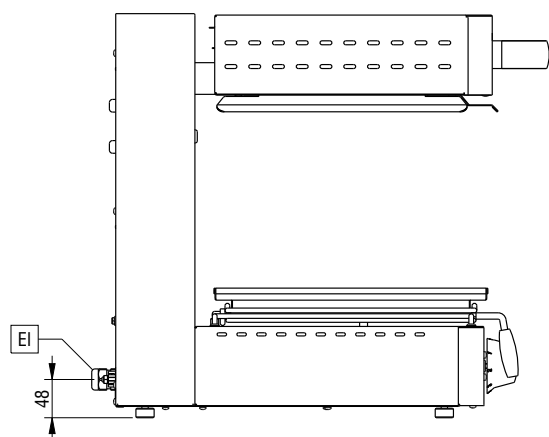

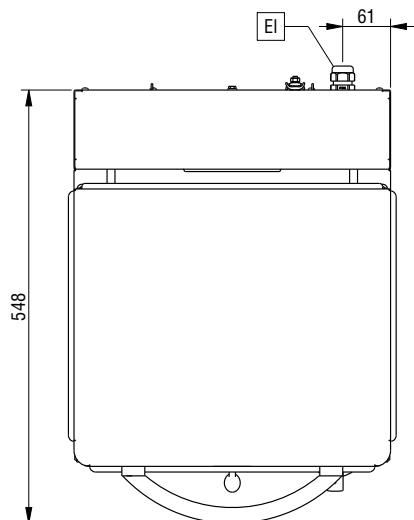
